ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 2010

**Amendment to Definition of Family**  
**Ann Arbor Charter Township Zoning Code Section 74-2**  
January 18, 2010

The following supersedes and replaces in its entirety the existing definition of “family” set forth in the Ann Arbor Charter Township Zoning Code Section 74-2.

*Family* means:

- (a) one or more persons related by blood, marriage or adoption, together with no more than 3 additional persons occupying a dwelling unit and living as a single housekeeping unit, or
- (b) a collective number of individuals living together in one dwelling unit under one head, whose relationship is of a permanent and distinct domestic character, and living as a single housekeeping unit. This definition shall not include any society, club, fraternity, sorority, association, lodge, group, coterie, organization, or other group of individuals whose association is temporary or seasonal in character or for an anticipated limited duration.
